Local jewellery designer Carolyn Kan's (below) Carrie K designs has been picked by Make One's Mark (MOM), a multi-label concept found in department stores in Japan that stocks designs by

budding fashion talent.

It is owned by Mr Yuji Yamamoto, the son of famed Japanese fashion designer Yohji Yamamoto.



Ms Kan met the younger Yamamoto at a Parco NextNext event here last November and her designs impressed the 42-year-old.

"She exuded both gracefulness and strength, qualities that translated into her work," said Mr Yamamoto in a press release.

Carrie K designs will be sold at the three MOM outlets in Tokyo. Prices start from about \$125 for a leather bracelet.

She is the first Singaporean to have her designs stocked there.
